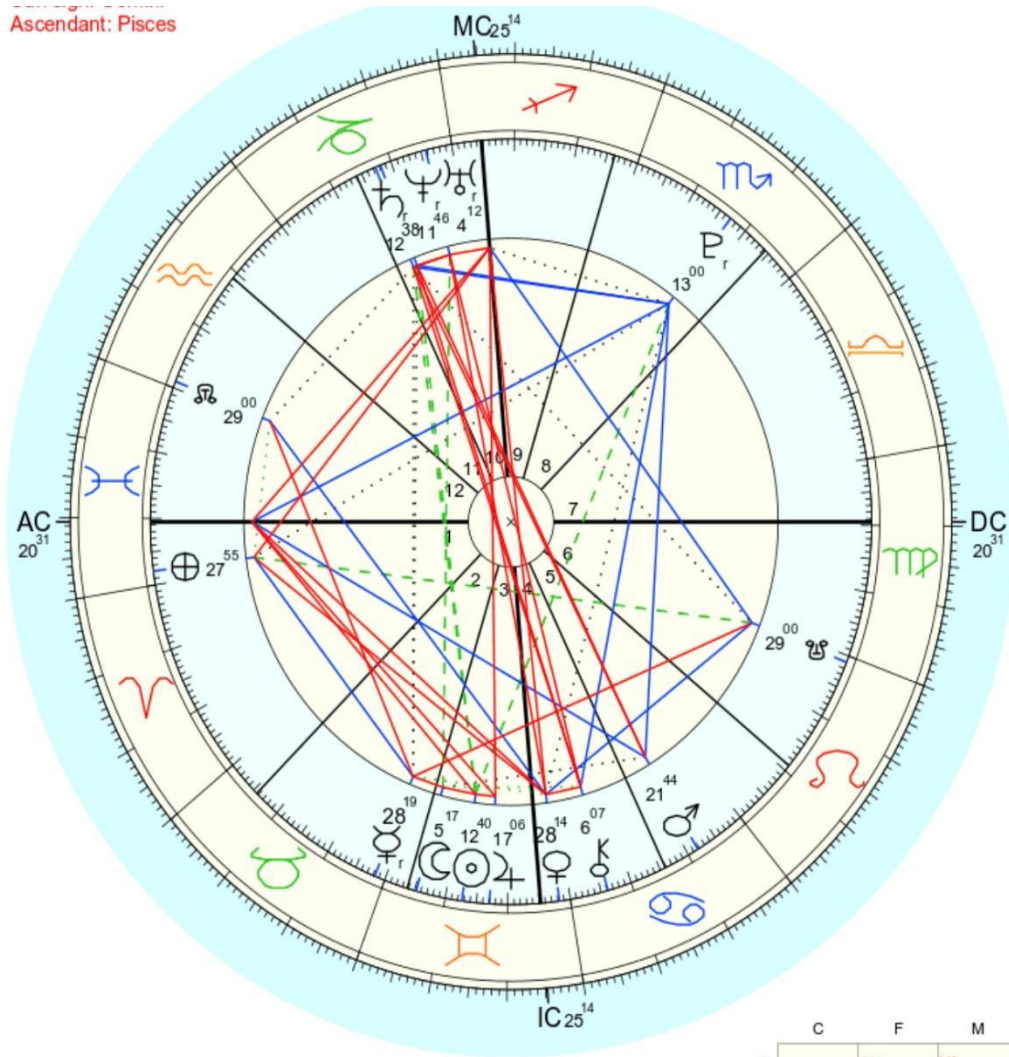

PART I: Natal Chart Stuff

North Node/South Node Axis

-North Node @ 29 Aquarius 00 in the 12th House

—Sabian Symbol for this degree is **“Deeply Rooted in The Past of A Very Ancient Culture, A Spiritual Brotherhood In Which Many Individual Minds Are Merged Into The Glowing Light Of A Unanimous Consciousness Is Revealed To One Who Has Emerged Successfully From His Metamorphosis.”**

-South Node @ 29 Leo 00 in the 6th House

—Sabin Symbol for this degree is **“an unsealed letter.”**

Just for clarifications sake, the North Node is like the mission of the soul in this lifetime. It is energy that your soul really wanted to learn to lean into/master this time around, while moving away from the more comfortable South Node qualities but keeping the best of these qualities and carrying them with you towards your North Node mission. The South Node represents energy that you are “comfortable” with because you’ve already “been there” in a previous life/previous lives (though comfortable does not always equal good). Since the North Node stays in the same sign for about 16-20 months, everyone born during that window of time around you will have their North Node in Aquarius...which makes the house placement/energy slightly more important than the sign that rules the North Node. I also want to point out that it's entirely possible (and really, probably likely) that the South Node will feel more like you in this present lifetime (or some of the themes may “feel” more familiar) until you begin your North Node evolutionary journey.

**Let me also make mention of one other thing here: because I am

always learning in my profession, and coming up with new theories and shit, I am kind of on the fence about whether the South Node represents the most recent previous lifetime OR the most recent previous lifetime connected to this one. It is my personal belief that in the span of ALL of our lifetimes across this dimension/on this planet, some will be more closely tied to some than others. **

You have your South Node in Leo in the 6th House (the sign tends to show HOW you functioned and the house tends to show the area(s) of life that you functioned in the most (and the planetary ruler of the South Node shows the same kind of thing)). There is something very animated and theatrical about Leo energy, and it does seem to me that you probably did live your most recent previous lifetime in very theatrical, animated, and even colorful ways. There is kind of a sense of “performing” with the South Node in Leo (or needing to be “on”), and since this is going on in the 6th House, this does seem like all of this Leo energy that I’m talking about came through via service (the 6th House is very service focused) in this previous lifetime, and in the work that you did (since the 6th house also deals with the work that you do and the way that you live daily life). I do think health probably ties into this, too (I’m actually thinking this could also involve mental health since Pluto is in the psychological 8th House and Mercury is squaring the Nodes....more on this part later). I think you were probably pretty involved in the local area around you with the Sun in the more “local” 3rd House, and probably very talkative and connector-like (and I also wouldn’t be surprised if you did some traveling around locally, too). This is actually how it feels like you might have been of service the most – connecting things in your local environments/bringing things and people together (and it wouldn’t surprise me since you seem to do a little of this in this lifetime, too), and I think it’s just as possible that you were brought together with people in your local environment (perhaps for the purposes of entertaining). It feels like your previous lifetime moved

very quickly (there is usually a quick or fast quality to the 3rd House in this context), and it does make me think that you may have had to quickly put on a different face or “performance” depending on who you were coming into contact with (I know you have mentioned merging with people and situations easily in this lifetime and it’s not as much of a choice; what I’m talking about in this previous lifetime was more of a “choice” (and I put that in quotes because I think you thought it was a choice, but I’m not sure it ended up always being a choice as time went on)).

You have the North Node in Aquarius in the 12th House. This means that in this lifetime, it is very important that you kind of go your own way – there is a freedom in being able to throw off the different feelings of needing to be of service to others (when I think of your South Node in Leo, I think of the lyrics **“here we are now, entertain us”** – you feeling like you need to entertain other people, to be of service to people in this way). Aquarius energy is all about freedom and kind of letting one’s freak flag fly, but I guess what is important here will be how and why you let your uniqueness come out to play. Is it to perform, get attention, or because you feel you need to “serve” other people in these ways? Or is because you are really feeling it in the moment? There is a need to detach from responsibilities that aren’t really yours in the first place (the 6th House tends to be all about duties and responsibilities) and I do think that with the Sun in the 3rd House and the South Node in Leo there was probably far too much duty that you felt towards connecting and communicating with other people, and in being some kind of service or entertainment for other people (or something along these lines). You need to be clear about what your responsibilities actually are, and it isn’t to strictly function like the South Node in Leo might want to function. That’s not to say that you completely detach from communicating with people and connecting people, but I do think

that this skill should be used to serve your own liberation, too (and along with freedom, Aquarius also needs to feel truly liberated). Since this is going on in the 12th House, this whole release of duties that don't actually serve your own freedom is a very spiritual thing for you. Not feeling like you always have to perform and be "on" is also a spiritual thing for you, too – just being able to be you in the moment. The planetary rulers of your North Node, Saturn and Uranus by traditional and modern rulership respectively, makes me think that there is a need that you have in this lifetime to kind of come into your own personal mastery and uniqueness in the public spheres of life (and this is very different than the "performances" or something like it that you put on in this previous lifetime to connect other people, to communicate with other people, and to connect yourself with other people in your environment). It's important that you are able to build something tangible in the career & public spheres of life (it may be different than the way that you were conditioned to think of career and the public spheres of life growing up, and that's fine – the important part is that you are able to create something solid/crystalized that means something to you...but it does need to be solid and crystalized). I think it's also important that you take the time to go inward when you need to with Saturn Rx and assess your current ambitions at any given time (do this every once in a while, to make sure that your dreams of what you are trying to build are lining up with the path that you're on). I feel like the self-undoing of the 12th House comes into play when you have no real goal or aim (and you will need to tune out the noise to do this best since your goals and aims are probably different than what you have been conditioned to have as goals and aims – I can't see this NOT being the case since Uranus and Saturn are both Rx). The goals and aims DO need to translate in the physical/world, though, since Capricorn is such a physical world sign energy (and both of these planets fall in Capricorn).

**I want to point something out about Uranus Rx in your natal chart - it happens to be conjunct the Lot of Status @ 3-degrees Capricorn and the Lot of Nemesis @5-degrees Capricorn. Lot of Status feels like it deals with one's public standing (and this feels even more highlighted since it falls in the 10th House). The Lot of Nemesis shows what *could* be one's downfall (I don't take this as literally, but it is an area of the chart that should have an eye kept on it). Since both of these are right up Uranus' ass (since it's at 4-degrees Capricorn), working Uranus from the Rx motion will be critical. Here's what I think: -Uranus Rx usually needs to either attach or detach from something, and in your case, Uranus Rx is quincunx your Moon (which means it's already kind of detached from what you emotionally need...at least to a certain extent). THIS feels like it could be your "downfall" – not being emotionally attached enough to your own perspective. Uranus Rx can see the birds eye point of view just fine, but I do feel that there is a tendency in your case NOT to include yourself enough (or your emotions) in the birds eye point of view that you are able to see. Make sure that when you see the birds eye point of view with things, that you are including your own emotions (and yourself) into this viewpoint (this is how you avoid a "downfall"). Attaching more to yourself should be the goal here. I think, when you do this, it also helps light up that Lot of Status, which does feel like it could be really powerful in your chart. I think Uranus Rx needs to be worked from Rx motion, first, before this can happen for you.

Skipped Steps

-Mercury @ 28 Taurus 19 in the 2nd House

--Sabian Symbol for this degree is **"two cobblers working at a table."**

Skipped Steps (planets that are square the Nodal Axis), are issues that we brought with us from previous lives into this lifetime. These

issues tend to be things that we neglected to take care of in our past lives (either by way of ignoring them, not taking care of/accomplishing them, abusing them, choosing to be unaware of them, or even something just flat out getting in the way). It is not until you work out the skipped step(s) in your natal chart that you will be able to fully evolve into your North Node mission. You have Mercury as a skipped step in your chart, and it is retrograde. Let's talk for a second about Mercury Rx in general.

******Mercury Rx is usually pretty fucking noisy, and by noisy, I mean lots of information coming someone's way all the time, in one's mental headspace. In Taurus, it seems like there could be a tendency to take in the more pleasurable kinds of information (or information that you find pleasurable and enjoyable), and since I do think that you find communication and information in general pleasurable (all those planets of yours in Gemini kind of screams this), I feel like you will need to learn how to tune out the noise (the information and the communication) that doesn't actually serve you and your own mental stability (mental stability is REALLY important here with Mercury in Taurus, and I feel like too much information coming into your headspace that doesn't actually serve you will make you feel more "mentally unstable" than you actually are, or might even cause you to feel mind fucked). This does feel like it is probably made a little more difficult since your 3rd House, 4th House, and 7th House all bend to Mercury in Taurus. This means that the greatest amount of noise probably comes from general communication and information that you take in/your environment (3rd House), from your family (4th House), and from close one on one relationships of all varieties (7th House). When someone is sharing something with you and communicating with you, you need to immediately ask yourself as a reflex "does what they are telling me help me to feel mentally

secure or does it make me feel mentally insecure?" If the information makes you feel mentally secure (and not mind fucked), then filter that information through to assimilate it further. If the information makes you feel mentally insecure or like you're being mind fucked in some way, I would filter that information in one ear and out the other real quick – let it go (Taurus energy can sometimes hoard or hold on to things – it's knowing what's actually of use to you to you mentally and what is not). Taurus energy likes things simple, so simplicity of information should be the goal (this actually does feel like it's something that you value, or it "should" be). ALL of this feels EVEN MORE IMPORTANT because you chose to come through in this lifetime with you Mercury in Taurus – I mean, you could've come through with it in the early degrees of Gemini and it still would've squared the nodes....you WANTED it in Taurus. This makes me think that you wanted to be able to tune out the noise and find mental security (and to value all of this) even more (and all of those planets in Gemini will dispose of themselves to Mercury in Taurus). The perception of security and stability also feels important and the value that you place on this (ideally, it should be valued pretty high). This needs to be in yourself most of all, and how you perceive this to be. **

Since Mercury is a skipped step in your chart, I'm thinking that you probably did take in far too much noise (information) which overly complicated your life in this previous lifetime. I almost get the feeling that you held on to things in your mind that you shouldn't have held on to, while kind of tossing the things that you should have been holding on to (and this does feel more value based, and self-value based – taking in too much of this from other people and depending on this less for yourself). Some of this, I feel like, came into play because you felt that you needed to serve other people by playing

different roles for these people in daily life per the Leo South Node in the 6th House. I do think that this probably ended up taking a toll on your physical and mental health (and how secure you felt within your own mind). Sometimes with Mercury squaring the nodes, there can be a sense of either being conned or doing the conning, and here I feel like the conning was done by you, but it was done to yourself (like, you mentally conning yourself). I think a lot of the information that you took in wasn't really relevant TO you, but I think you conned yourself in thinking that it was (even though I do think there was probably a little intuitive voice trying to break through saying "this really isn't important to you and your purpose – let it go"). This all feels that it was probably incredibly mentally confusing to you, though I think you may have conned yourself into thinking that you weren't confused (and I also think that life moved fast enough in this previous lifetime with the Sun in the 3rd House in Gemini that you may not have had a whole bunch of free time to separate what was confusing to you versus what wasn't). You definitely do need to tap into your intuition in this lifetime to help you separate what mentally matters to you versus what actually doesn't – and I do think that you can do it when you go inward mentally (taking the necessary time to slowly do this) – it's also very mentally grounding to you when you do this.

****Something else that makes me think of health in this context** (beyond just the South Node in the 6th House) is that the South Node is quincunx your Part of Fortune (and the Part of Fortune, like the 6th House, can deal with physical health). The quincunx aspect from this angle makes me think that there were things that you didn't "see" in regard to your physical health in this previous lifetime, and I do think that this is more mental in nature with Mercury squaring the nodes. It almost feels like if you had allowed yourself to slow down a little bit,

you would've been able to see whatever was going on more clearly (and I mention "slow down" because Mercury is in Taurus and does function best when it can slow down just a little bit – when it can take the time to slow down when necessary).**

**From a "this lifetime" lens, there is a mutual reception between Venus in Gemini and Mercury in Taurus. This strengthens the idea that you need to both value your own perception, along with your mind, per Venus in Gemini (and this is very core related since Venus is conjunct the IC). When you do this, the perception of what you value (and even the way that you value your mind) is strengthened and secured per Mercury in Taurus. I think there is also probably something to be said about how you value money and tangible resources (that probably comes through in this lifetime as more confusing than anything – or in a way that may not always translate as easily in the physical world). Mercury can also be tangible currency (cash in hand kind of thing), and I'm wondering if you valued money in kind of a backwards or incomplete way. It's not ALL about money (there is much more to life than just money, lol), but I do think there should be healthy amount of respect for it, and of actual understanding of it, in this lifetime. I almost feel like you may not have always gotten paid for your services in this previous lifetime like you should have (or maybe the way you got paid wasn't in a way that allowed you to stand on your own – kept you in a state of service rather than allowing you freedom). Life isn't all about money, but money (or tangible security) does allow one to have a certain amount of freedom they wouldn't have otherwise (and freedom is very important to you North Node in Aquarius).

**I know I mentioned that you might feel like you are mind fucked from time to time. My advice here is to make sure that you aren't contributing to feeling mind fucked.

Pluto & the Pluto Polarity Point

Pluto @ 13 Scorpio 00 in the 8th House

Sabian Symbol for Pluto is **“telephone lineman at work installing new connections.”**

Pluto Polarity Point @ 13 Taurus 00 in the 2nd House

Sabian Symbol for Pluto Polarity Point is **“on the beach, children play as shellfish grope at the edge of the water.”**

Pluto and the Pluto Polarity Point (opposite Pluto) operate in a similar fashion to the North and South Nodes (they just help to flesh out the story even further), with Pluto operating similarly to the South Node, and the Pluto Polarity Point operating similarly to the North Node. You have Pluto in the 8th House, which makes me think that your most recent previous lifetime was probably centered on other people to at least a certain extent (their values and their resources). I also feel like there is probably something psychological going on from this lens as well, but here it feels psychological in regard to feeling that you needed other people's values and resources to kind of “make do” (if that makes sense – and it does feel like more a need here than an actual want). This may not have been completely conscious to you since the 8th House isn't completely conscious as it is, but I definitely think something in your subconscious made you think that. I also wouldn't be surprised if sex tied in here, especially with the other planetary ruler of Scorpio, Mars, falling in the 5th House (which can deal with the lighter sides of sex). It could be something along the lines of feeling that you needed to give over your sexuality to other people for their resources and values, or to get from them that which you didn't feel that you could get on your own (or something along

those lines). That's not to say that you didn't enjoy what you did (Mars trine Pluto makes me think that you probably did and it wasn't exactly forced or anything like that), but the security that you found in yourself (and your own sense of value and worth, and even your own sense of value in your own resources) does feel like it was lacking and that the pendulum swung in the direction of "others" and their resources and values. That should probably stop in this lifetime just a little bit (or a lot), especially with Mercury (and the way that you think) being a skipped step. Mercury also falls in the same sign and house as the Pluto Polarity Point (they're not conjunct but being in the same house and sign does feel important here all the same). I think, with Mercury in Taurus Rx, you need to also watch for taking in too many values and resources from other people as it is (things that are really more noise than they help you to actually survive – and the 2nd House does deal with survival). Since the Pluto Polarity Point falls in Taurus in the 2nd House, it does make me think that actual security and stability (and even survival) in the physical/real world is important, but this does need to come from you more than it needs to come from other people. I think when you try to find this security, stability, and survival via other people in this lifetime you probably end up more confused than you need to be (and also as if part of you is not actually "free" – and that true freedom IS important to you North Node in Aquarius). It's very hard to be truly free when you are needing to bend to what other people need (or need you to be) or relying on other people for your own survival. Now, in saying this, it doesn't mean that you can't have other people in your life or that you can't depend on others ever (I'm not saying that at ALL). I think it's important that the deep connections that you make with other people aren't based off of necessity and are based on the fact that you actually want these

deep connections in the first place (and I do think some of the connections or relationships that you find yourself in, if you really think about it, aren't actually relationships or connections that you would have (or have for as long, or in the same way) IF you had true freedom and didn't feel that you needed certain people to survive).

I also want to talk for a minute about Aries intercepted in the 1st House and Libra intercepted in the 7th House from this lens. The interceptions on their own tend to show some kind of fuckery with the way that you think of the concept of yourself as an independent person (per Aries in the 1st House), and how you think about the concept of "the other" (per Libra in the 7th house). With Libra intercepted in the 7th (and Virgo on the cusp), I feel like you are probably geared towards being serving towards others in relationships, but this doesn't feel like in traditional ways. I feel like you might tend to become what the other person needs (which ultimately ends up confusing you, especially with your Mercury, the ruler of Virgo, as a skipped step and retrograde – confusing your perception of security and stability). Libra also deals with equal partnerships, and it's really important that you FIND close relationships of all varieties where you on equal footing with the other person. Virgo actually on the cusp (and Virgo deals with unequal relationships) makes me think that you are more geared to relationships that aren't as equal (either with you compromising too much of yourself in service of the relationship or with needing to be served by the relationship...there could be a little of this, too). Since Aries is intercepted in the 1st house, I do think that trying to solidly figure out who you actually are is both important and a challenge (and not just being whoever you feel like you need to be in any

given situation to get by). There is nothing wrong with approaching the world in the fluid way that your Pisces Ascendant does approach the world (it can be a lovely thing for you and others), but you do need to really know who you are, so you don't get kind of swept up or swept away to the whims (or what feels like service or even needing to be served by) to others.

-To work with the interceptions (or pull those signs from interception), you would want to look at Mars in the 5th House in Cancer, and Venus in the 4th House in Gemini conjunct the IC. Your Mars is in Cancer in the 5th House, which means the things that ultimately drive you most in your creative self-expression should be very, very personal. This really should be from you (and should mean something to you – you are driven to create things that mean something to you emotionally). If you want to find more, say, creative types of work/jobs, you will need to somehow feel emotionally attached towards whatever work you do in this capacity. Mars in Cancer is actually pretty protective (and even defensive), but when I think of it here, I feel like if you ever wanted to get out of your comfort zone (which I do think is good for you sometimes), defending and protecting something that means something to you would be the way to go...things like defending the homeland in some way and the family stand out since Cancer deals with both of these notions (this probably makes you feel pretty independent and allows you to assert yourself in a way that Cancer Mars may not always feel comfortable doing). I would also like to point out with the family notion of Cancer, and Mars being so driven, you probably are driven to create your own family (whatever that ends up looking like or what family means to you). There definitely is, I think, an unlocking of that Aries energy that is intercepted once this occurs for you (do make sure that you are prepared for this, though – that's just

generally good advice).

-Venus is the planetary ruler of Libra intercepted, and it happens to conjunct your IC in the 4th House. I think it's really important that you, first and foremost, value yourself at your core (this is just super fucking important). I feel like you don't do this enough and this is another reason why you might kind of blend and merge with other people easily, becoming who and what they need you to become (or what you think they want you to become). At the same time, I think you could not value yourself the way that you should, which could cause you to be more reliant on other people in relationships (in a way that actually doesn't serve you, even if it's "easier" to go this route). The value that you place on your own perception of things is also very important (your perception alone – and I mention this since the core of YOU is involved here). Knowing your own perception of things matters a lot (and then you can integrate them in with other peoples, but your own perception needs to be firm, first (and this is also backed up with the mutual reception with Mercury in Taurus, and this perception being something that you value).

**Since Venus is conjunct the Galactic Anti-Center, it does make me wonder if this might be a kind of "blind-spot" for you – being able to see what you clearly value about yourself in the first place. It's not that you can't see or feel Venus at all (I don't think it's so "blinded" that you can't see or feel anything having to do with it, but I think there could be some things about yourself that you don't value the way that you should- and this does feel like it is very perception related more than anything). I might even go as far as to say that there might be things about your place in the public spheres of life that aren't valued "correctly" either, since Venus opposes the Midheaven. My advice here (and take it or leave it), but you're your Midheaven gets "shocked" at different points in your life (and I do

think it probably does and will), make sure that you take those moments (or periods) of being “shocked” to assess what you value most, what you love most, and other things of a Venusian nature. The shocking isn't usually a fun experience, but the clarity the shocking can provide is very illuminating.

-Taking time to decipher what you value in general, what matters most to you without any influence or noise from other people, is also a good exercise for you to engage (at least from time to time).

The Life That (I Think) You Lived

There is no sure-fire way to know exactly WHAT sex someone was in a past life, but I do think with Pluto in Scorpio and in the 8th House (both of which are more feminine), Mars, the traditional ruler of Scorpio, in the feminine sign of Cancer, and the South Node in the 6th House (which is also more feminine), the chances of you having been a female are pretty strong. Just the mentions that you've made about feeling more comfortable with females in general in this current lifetime makes me think that you probably connect with female energy for this reason (having been a female in a past life). The only real “masculine” marker that you have is your South Node in Leo (the planetary ruler of the South Node, the Sun, falls in the more androgynous 3rd House and Gemini (I think of both of these as more androgynous))so yeah, I'm going with you having been a female in a past life. For the time period....I'm thinking this may have been in the early 1740's (I'm not sure if you were BORN then, or if you just lived the “apex” of your life at this time). Either way, I do think you were alive then. I came to this conclusion because transit Pluto was at the same degree as your natal Pluto in the early 1740's, and the

North Node at this time happened to be in Taurus around the same degree as your natal Mercury (and since Mercury is a skipped step in this lifetime, it doesn't surprise me to some Nodal Axis involvement from this time period with your natal Mercury). As far as where you lived, I'm focusing strongest on Gemini (and places with an affinity to Gemini) since the planetary ruler of your South Node is in Gemini. This energy actually deals heavily with the Americas (specifically North America – and even more specifically the eastern part of the United States and Eastern Canada). This is what I'm going to roll with here.

I know that you have joked about being a “slut” or “slutting it up” or something along those lines (I know you don't mean it literally in this lifetime, you're just kind of “playing” when you say it), but in looking at your chart I have to wonder if there is some kind of prostitution thing going on from a past life lens that kind of plays out in this life as you “prostituting” yourself in other ways that might not be sexual in nature (but, perhaps, in having been a prostitute in a previous lifetime, this inclination to “whore” yourself out kind of comes around this time, too). There is definitely an entertainment vibe to the service that you provided per the South Node in Leo in the 6th House, and there is a traveling aspect (regional travel) since the Sun is in the 3rd House, so it does kind of make me wonder if you were part of some kind of traveling peep show (lol peep show), or something of that nature. The other option, here, is that you were, like, the entertainment for people who would travel to the place that you lived, or even traveling with different people locally (being their entertainment and “companion” for the time). Whatever exactly it was, it was not anything particularly permanent (the Sun in the 3rd House from this lens doesn't lend itself to permanence, and the 3rd House moves fucking fast). There is definitely sex involved here (or

some type of intimacy that does feel sexual in nature) since Pluto falls in Scorpio in the 8th House (and the 8th House deals with sex and sexuality, along with a bunch of other shit). With the 8th House, there is also a need to form a bond with someone else, and I'm thinking that you did have this need in a previous lifetime, but I don't think it got figured out correctly (and I think this could be one of the reasons that Mercury showed up as a skipped step in this lifetime – something about the perception of stability was amiss). I think with the other planetary ruler of Scorpio, Mars, in Cancer in the 5th House and trining Pluto, you didn't mind the sex here (it wasn't like you were forced to do anything – it was just kind of what you did), and I do think with Mars in 5th House (which deals with the lighter sides of sex, dating, and enjoyment...among other things) you probably did enjoy what you did. I don't think you ever found any real security through yourself, though – it was always kind of dependent upon someone else (some kind of close relationship in the moment), their values, their money, and how much you enjoyed the situation. I do also wonder about your health here from this lens since we are talking about a 6th House South Node (and the 6th House deals with work, service, and health....among other things), and also because your natal Part of Fortune quincunxes your South Node (which does make me think you didn't see something about your health or physical body clearly in this previous lifetime (and since the PoF is in Pisces, this lack of clarity feels all the more possible). I don't think that you took care of yourself the way that you should – you were looking for security in things that were outside of yourself (and your own resources and values) and more short term in nature, but your own physical security was left out of it. I know I mentioned this to you, but I do wonder if you could've ended up with something like syphilis (or some other STD that wasn't able to be treated at the time). While I

can't actually SEE your death (it doesn't look like it occurred in some kind of catastrophic accident or anything like that), but the 6th House South Node and the PoF make me do think that health was involved. I mention syphilis specifically since I know that it can fuck with one's mind, and with your own Mercury as a skipped step, I do think there was something going on here (like, had you taken better care of your own health, Mercury may not have shown up as a skipped step). Or maybe it would've since I do think Mercury as a skipped step represents more than JUST this (I do think this plays in, though).

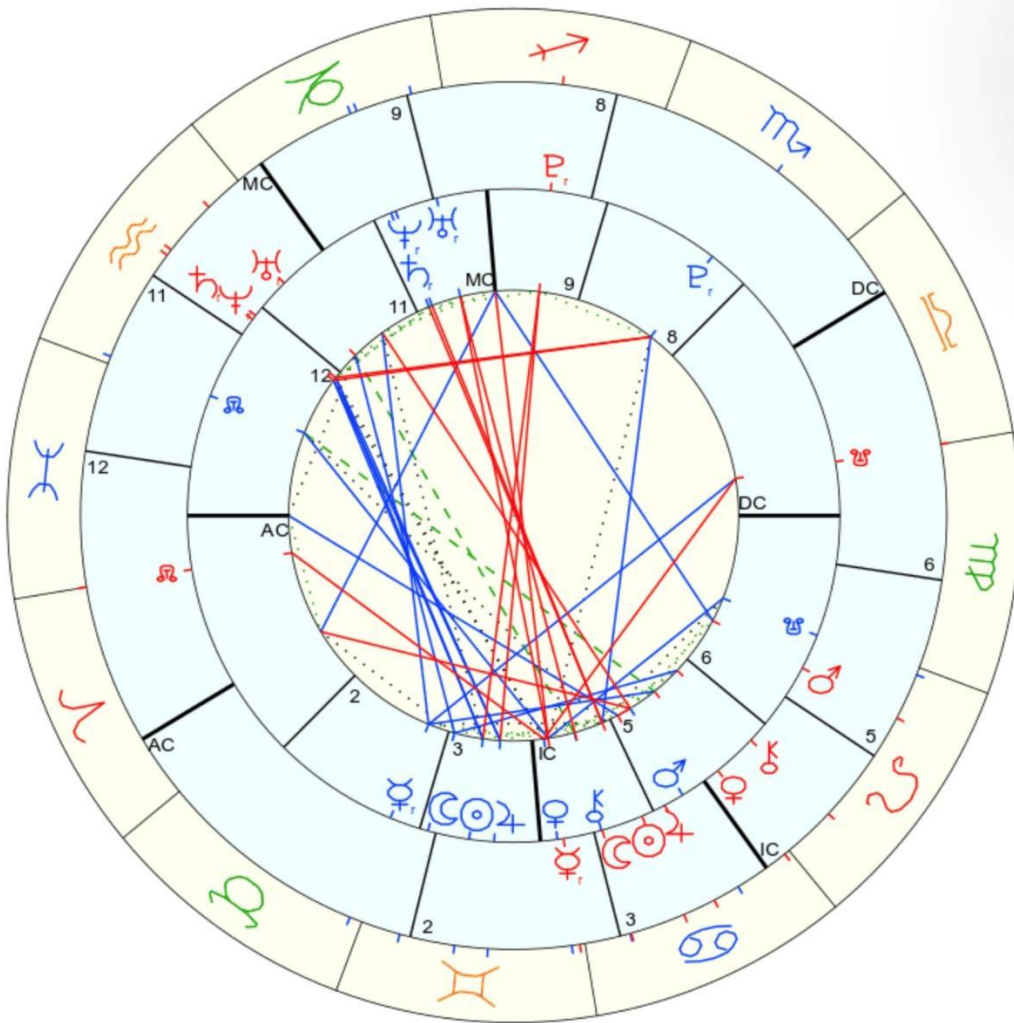
From what I can see, the 2nd House is incredibly important since this is where the Pluto Polarity Point falls in your chart, and where Mercury as a skipped step falls (Taurus energy is important for the same reason). Security and stability in the "real" and physical world are so important for you, and this really does need to be something that you find through yourself most of all. This doesn't mean that you can't have intimate relationships with other people, but you can't depend on these relationships for survival (and really, I would branch this out beyond just intimate relationships – you can't be counting on other people's values or resources for survival in general). Your perception of yourself (and of what stability is) isn't "on point" when you rely on other people for these reasons. I also don't think it helps the true freedom that your North Node in Aquarius in the 12th House needs most of all – this kind of freedom knows no limits or boundaries. How can you really have this kind of freedom if you are relying on other people's resources or values for survival? Maybe there is a way to do this, but I really can't think of one that doesn't keep you in chains in some way to someone else, or in service to someone else (and at the highest vibration, that 12th House breaks and strips away chains and other bullshit). The "service" here might look more like just

having to be someone for someone else (even if you would rather not have to do this), and I almost wonder if some of the restlessness in this lifetime (or even anxiousness), or feeling like you need to move around (and not get too “comfortable”) has to do with this – not wanting to feel like you have to settle into some kind of life that isn’t actually built from you and for you. If this is what is going on, the notion of comfort probably is a difficult thing for you, but I do think the more that you try to find security in yourself (your own resources and your own values), the less of an issue with being comfortable you have (because this comfort is based on you, and you find it through you). This doesn’t mean that you can’t find comfort with other people (that would be a ridiculous thing to say), but I do think it’s important that you find it in yourself, first.

I would also think that the 10th House is incredibly important in your chart since both of the planetary rulers of the North Node fall there. It does feel important that you have a career (or a public presence/image/reputation) that does mean something to you and that you believe in (and I mention this since Sagittarius is on the cusp of the 10th House). It also does need to translate into the physical world since Capricorn is such a physically rooted sign. Things that tie to the 10th House probably will be handled a little differently since Uranus and Saturn are both Rx (different than you might think things like career, etc. are “supposed” to look or have been conditioned to think they should look), and that’s fine (it’s how you’re supposed to go. What you build here should be solid and should be able to translate into the real world – this is also a source of freedom and liberation for you, and it’s also a way that I think you are able to “escape” the way that I think you like to be able to escape (this is how the escape element of the 12th House should function since the

12th House disposes of itself to the 10th – escape should be found through career or other 10th House areas of life). Spirituality is another way that this could come through – doing something in the public spheres of life where your spirituality is able to come through (whatever this looks like for you). Any grief and pain that you keep in the 12th House (and I think here this would deal with the chains that you wear to “service” and dependency per your South Node) needs to be released via the career that you choose to take on (and I do think there is something freeing and liberating about all of this for you).

PART II: Draconic Chart Stuff

The Draconic Chart (the chart of the soul across all incarnations)

Just for a little bit of background, in case you are not totally familiar, the Draconic Chart is considered to be the chart of the soul across all incarnations, time, and space. It is calculated by setting the North Node to 0 degrees Aries and depending on how far away your Natal North Node is from 0 degrees Aries it will cause the chart to shift a little, or a lot. The signs will change, and the degrees will change, but your planets will remain in the same houses that they are in your natal chart. As far as the aspects that are the most important when looking at the Draconic to Natal comparison goes, the conjunction is far and away the most important. When looking at the comparison from the Natal to Draconic Chart, you also want to keep the orbs for the aspects on the tight side (5 or 6 degrees is typically where I like to keep the orbs, really, and even tighter if I can).

As far as the Draconic Chart goes (and any soul work I do for people), I need to explain just a little bit of where I'm coming from when I do this work for people in a deeper way than I usually do when answering questions on forums (and on my blog). When I say the Draconic Chart is the chart of the soul across all time and space, I mean in this "dimension." Let me explain: I believe that there are several dimensions/levels/etc. that we can ascend towards, and we spend several incarnations in each dimension. The Draconic Chart, to me anyway, is the chart of the soul for the current dimension. When we have finally completed everything that our soul wants to complete in this particular dimension, we are able to ascend to the next dimension and you would then have another Draconic Chart (or something of the sort, whatever they are called in the next

dimension) that you would carry with you through each incarnation. So, while this is the chart of the soul, it is only the chart of the soul for this particular dimension. I also firmly believe that not only do we get to “pick” our natal charts or at least elements of it while in the “in-between” (the natal chart being the full mask that we wear during each incarnation), but we also get to “pick” our Draconic Chart (or elements of it) once we reach a new dimension in which to live out our incarnations. While the natal chart shows things that our soul wants to work on in each specific incarnation, the Draconic Chart shows what our soul wants to work on over the course of each incarnation in a specific dimension.

When looking at draconic charts it is always especially important to look at the draconic Moon. The Sun is thought of as the life force in the natal chart, but the draconic Moon is very much the soul force of the Draconic Chart. Your Draconic Moon is in Cancer (still in the 3rd House of the draconic chart since the houses don't change). This definitely gives you an undercurrent of Cancerian energy to your Gemini Moon in this lifetime. It probably makes you a little more sensitive than the typical Gemini Moon, though I would imagine since your natal Moon is in Gemini you are able to, kind of, talk through your feelings to yourself. I also think you can verbalize your feelings well in this lifetime, too, when you feel comfortable enough to do so (verbalize them well towards other people, though the draconic Cancer Moon is going to be a little choosier with who you do this with, probably – comfort is going to be paramount before you become emotionally verbose). This actually makes you feel emotionally good and is very helpful for you in not getting so in your own head in this lifetime with your natal Moon. Gemini Moons can get caught up in their own head with their feelings, or with trying to

make sense of their feelings (and these feelings can come and go very quickly). In the time between incarnations in this realm, you probably are more outwardly emotionally sensitive than you might always feel comfortable being in this lifetime, but I think the more that you do keep inside your head and don't let out, the more uncomfortable you probably feel in this lifetime (so it really is important that you find people that you can really share things with – and not just sharing random information and stuff, but really sharing things about yourself). Sometimes, I think in lifetime, you might be inclined to share things quickly with other people (like information) or do the connecting people to other people and feel like this is emotionally fulfilling (and there probably IS some emotional fulfillment found in operating this way – I don't doubt it for a second). I do wonder though, with the draconic Moon damn near dead ass conjunct natal Chiron, if some of this is done to keep that natal Moon busy so natal Chiron isn't felt as much (and with the draconic Moon conjunct natal Chiron, it definitely makes Chiron more sensitive). There is definitely family, home, and core wounding in this lifetime (since natal Chiron falls in the 4th House and in Cancer), and this isn't a wounding that can be “gone around”. Your draconic Moon conjunct natal Chiron probably makes you more sensitive to your own pain, and it also probably makes you more sensitive to the pain of those that you are close with as well. Pain, unfortunately, is a part of life for everyone, and another quote comes to mind when I think of this conjunction between these charts:

“The truth is, everyone is going to hurt you. You just have to find the ones worth suffering for.”

It's important that you know that you are worth “suffering” for – not just you to yourself, but you're worth it for someone else, too. Not that I want you or anyone else to suffer, but I hope you know what I

mean when I use that quote. This is something that you needed to see very clearly this time around, and I think when you see this, it helps you immensely. I also think it is incredibly important that you have a home (and a family environment) that actually feels comfortable for you (and this probably comes through with the people that you consider family or the family that you create for yourself – blood family may always be a little more difficult this way). Without that comfortable environment, and without people that make you feel comfortable, I think you will kind of feel like “something is missing.”

-Your draconic Sun falling in Cancer is going to amplify everything just mentioned about the draconic Moon (since they are still conjunct in the draconic chart and the draconic Moon is slightly more important than the draconic Sun). Both of these planets falling in the 4th House of your natal chart in house overlays and being in the more emotional and sensitive sign of Cancer will doubly make you a more sensitive, emotional, and even “moody” Gemini than you might otherwise be. It’s also doubly important that you have a foundation that makes you feel secure (and this really does feel like more of a home base than anything in this lifetime). Something that is yours and is a shelter from the storm (somewhere you can go that is completely your domain). This helps you to feel more secure in yourself in this lifetime.

Your draconic Ascendant is in Aries, which makes your draconic chart ruler Mars in Leo. This is interesting to me since in your natal chart Aries is intercepted. It does make me think that Aries energy IS accessible to you, along with Libra energy, at least as an undercurrent in this lifetime. It also probably makes you more driven than you might always realize that you are, and it definitely makes

you able to relate to your sense of self (though, again, this is as an undercurrent). The draconic chart ruler is Mars, and this is in Leo...and it's very close to the natal South Node (it's a little wider than I would usually look at for conjunctions, but I feel like it should be counted here). It makes me think that "you" by first dispositions in the draconic chart is able to kind of spur on growth (kind of kicking your ass in gear to move beyond the South Node....even if draconic Mars might feel comfortable functioning like the natal South Node). There probably IS something about your South Node that you should hold on to, and I do think it's the boldness – you just need to leave being the entertainment behind (or that's how I think of that Mars in Leo in this case – that fucker is bold).

You have your natal Venus conjunct your draconic Mercury Rx, and this feels kind of interesting to me (stay with me here because what I want to say I might kind of jump around a little bit rather than JUST talking about draconic Mercury and natal Venus). Mercury Rx can be pretty noisy, and even noisier when it happens to fall in Gemini (so this makes me think that you might take in even more of what feels like "noise" in the in-between (or be inclined to take this in)). However, when your soul trusts its intuition, I think things do become less noisy. Here's the thing about that, though (and I do think it can carry over into this lifetime too) – the organization feels off of how you organize your intuition at times (like the way that you organize what you are intuiting and why you are intuiting it – this stuff DOES need to be organized so that you can see the big picture which is something that Mercury Rx needs to be able to do via the trusting of its intuition). Since this happens to conjunct your natal Venus, I do think that natal Venus could be hit with some of this noise (and is also probably hit with it due to the mutual reception between natal

Venus and natal Mercury). I think this noise could make natal Venus a little more restless, so I think it's very important that when you start feeling restless at your core that you try to put the pieces together, piece by piece and step by step, of what it is that you're taking in (and what you don't need to be taking in), along with what you feel most restless about – getting to the bottom of this is important. It's also interesting that in the draconic chart, Taurus is intercepted in the 1st House. and since your Mercury Rx skipped step in the natal chart falls in Taurus in the 2nd House, it does seem that Taurus energy is important not just in this lifetime but across ALL lifetimes (and there is probably something to be learned about being more personally secure across all incarnations – this does seem like a goal across all time and space (and pulling draconic Taurus and Scorpio energy from the interceptions). In this context, it feels like it deals a lot with being able to start what you finish (and this is pretty personal since Taurus is intercepted in the 1st House), and with knowing what is actually worth holding on to/what should be transformed beyond via Scorpio energy (and this would deal with close relationships of all varieties since Scorpio is intercepted in the draconic 7th House).

**That one kind of veered off into other territory and I hope it made some fucking sense lol. Figuring Mercury Rx as a skipped step in THIS lifetime definitely seems to be important to you figuring things out that you wanted to learn across all lifetimes regarding Taurus (and even Scorpio) energy – it probably helps thing to “click” into place.

You have your draconic Jupiter conjunct your natal Mars, which makes your natal Mars feel a little more “powerful” than it does just looking at the natal chart alone. Jupiter is exalted in Cancer, which gives it a lot of strength (so you definitely have some kind of luck on your side). Because Jupiter does things in a big way, and the

exaltation kind of makes this even more true, it does feel like when you are driven towards the things that I mentioned in the other section (where your drive shines best of all), you can do some really great things. If you aren't driven (or aren't using your drive in the ways, or similar ways, to what I mentioned), I could see you feeling more lost (and kind of aimless), again, in a big way. I also think with draconic Jupiter touching natal Mars, you wanted to understand something about being driven in this lifetime (or wanted to understand drive) from the personal sign of Cancer. This actually makes some sense to me especially with your draconic Mars touching your natal South Node (and perhaps being more inclined towards being driven in the realms of service/serving in a way that isn't as personal, and is perhaps more for show, in the time between lives). You wanted to make this all more personal in this lifetime.

I like to look at Draconic Pluto and the Draconic Pluto Polarity Point as well, since I think of these in the Draconic Chart as where your soul came from before it started incarnating into this realm (what it's comfortable with), and I think of the Draconic Pluto Polarity Point as where your soul wanted to go (or go towards) in the different incarnations in this realm. You have your draconic Pluto in Sagittarius (still in the 8th House), which makes me think that you come into these different incarnations on Earth a little more detached from Earth (Sagittarius energy is a little bit half in the clouds and half on the ground). This energy knows things and understands things (and since this is going on in the 8th House of the draconic chart, this is deeply felt (especially with draconic Jupiter in Cancer)). I would also think that many of your beliefs across all incarnations are those that come from other people (their values and their beliefs), while maybe being a little less firm standing in your own (you definitely have them

with draconic Jupiter in Cancer, but they don't feel as easily expressed since Cancer is more private). It's funny because you are SUCH a communicator (especially in this lifetime), but I think when it comes to communicating things about yourself (that are personal to you and your own beliefs and things) you might have a more difficult time communicating. I do think this is something that you wanted to figure out across all lifetimes (which could be why you came through in this lifetime with all that Gemini in your chart). The draconic Pluto Polarity Point is in Gemini (and it also happens to be conjunct your natal Sun and natal Jupiter). Gemini energy is definitely something that you wanted to understand better in this lifetime, but in a more stable way (and I bring that up since the draconic Pluto Polarity Point falls in the draconic 2nd House). You can be stable while still having flexibility and movability (this is possible). To me, the Gemini energy here speaks of needing to come down to Earth (bringing the stuff that you understand via draconic Pluto in Sagittarius across all incarnations down to Earth (I think of Gemini energy as being more "localized" or coming down to Earth)). Communicating what you know also seems important this time around, especially with the draconic Pluto Polarity Point conjunct your natal Sun in the natal 3rd House. Not keeping personal things that you know to yourself, and then kind of communicating things but in less personal ways (or instead you might communicate things that aren't personal back out into the world...and in that sense might kind of contribute to the noise) – you need to be sharing what you actually know and understand (and not just more "shallow" communication). This helps you to better get in touch with your sense of self in this lifetime, and I also think it helps to give you a greater sense of self-understanding & self-belief with your natal Sun conjunct natal Jupiter.
